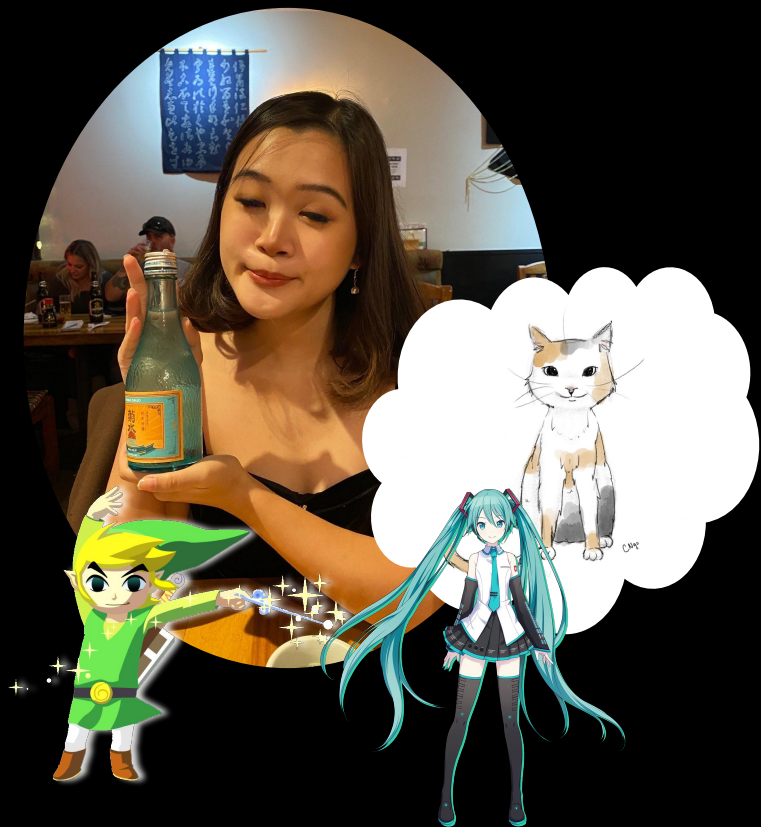
About Me
